

Funding Requests:

Thrive – Department of Health and Wellness

- **After the Bell** – This funding program is available for girls programming at the junior high level. We received funding from this grant for part of the girls program at ESDC last year. **Funding accepted (\$3911.38)**. A cheque for has been requisitioned as of October 30th, 2015.
- **Facility Access Grant** – This grant is to offer free access to recreational facilities in the area for families. **\$5000 funding approved**. A cheque has been requisitioned as of September 1st, 2015.

RDG – Department of Health and Wellness

- **Actifs après l'école** – A partnership between the municipality, the CSAP and Health and Wellness that provides a leader to supervise a non competitive physical activity session for youth in grades 3-6 on day per week in the afterschool period. **\$2000 funding approved**. A cheque has been requisitioned as of September 22nd, 2015.

Awards Proposals

- **Mayflower Community Cooperation Award** - Recreation Nova Scotia Award – Nominees are : the Clare Senior Fun Day – shuffleboard committee, and in particular Clara Melanson, Patricia Melanson and Irene Lombard (posthumously). Award for cooperation and collaboration of communities for programs or activities resulting in healthier futures through active lifestyles. **Did not receive**.

Follow up on MPAL group activities and programs

- **Actifs après l'école** – After school program that offers non competitive physical activity once a week has begun in all four elementary schools. Thus far, we have been surpassing last year's attendance levels.
- **Conect2 – Bike Racks** – Bike racks are ready and hardware for installation has been ordered. Currently working on getting the six sites that require cement pads to be dug up and prepared for cement pouring.

- **Equipment Loan Program** – 16 pairs of snowshoes have arrived as of October 2nd, 2015. PDFs have been placed on backorder; expected to arrive late November/early December.
- **Facility Access** – Program has begun; high attendance during the free skate (Sundays), less during the free swim (Saturdays).
- **Gran Fondo** – Newly appointed as Equipment Manager.
- **Sentiers de Clare Rails to Trails** – recording secretary for meetings about 5-6 times per year – next meeting will be December 7th, 2015.
- **Soyons Actifs** – On every Monday, that is not a holiday, the municipality rents the pool or rink and buses all elementary school children who wish to attend the activity. Program has started, and has been receiving impressive regular attendance; 50-60 children each week, so far, with one week that the bus was unavailable so parents had to provide transportation.
